

GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION OF SUBJECTS

In furtherance of the aim of this college to offer a balanced curriculum across a wide range of subjects and skills, we offer the **ICE** (International Certificate of Examination) option of the IGCSE, which is a group examination in which candidates are required to reach certain standards in a group of subjects in order to gain a certificate.

All candidates for the ICE must enter and sit for at least 7 subjects and must include:

TWO (different) subjects from GROUP 1(LANGUAGES)

- ONE subject from each of groups 2,3,4 and 5
- SEVENTH subject from any of the 5 IGCSE syllabus groups

Accordingly, the school's policy for subject selection is as follows

- First Language English, Foreign Language French, Literature, Mathematics and Computer Studies OR Information Technology are compulsory for all students.
- At least one subject should be chosen from Group 3(Sciences).
- Students are to offer a minimum of 8 subjects (including the compulsory ones stated above)
- Students **may** offer a maximum of 10 subjects, depending on timetabling constraints.
