JOB TITLE - GEOGRAPHY TEACHER

I. ROLE OVERVIEW

The role involves planning, implementing, and delivering Geography Courses in MYP and DP to enable students to gain a thorough knowledge of the subject and to excel in both the internal and external assessments to facilitate access into tertiary institutions or to pursue other avenues of learning or careers.

II. DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. Teaching and Curriculum Planning:
- 1. Teaching MYP and DP Geography courses in line with IB-approved guides
- 2. Developing Unit and Lesson plans for effective teaching
- 3. Drawing up a teaching programme/Scheme of work for syllabus implementation
- 4. Setting and marking assessment tasks classwork and internal examinations according to the school's assessment policy
- 5. Maintaining discipline in and out of the classroom
- 6. Fostering, implementing, and upholding the objectives and philosophy of the College
- 7. Drawing up lists of books and equipment required for teaching the subject. The lists are handed over to the Head of Department.
- B. Assessment and Evaluation:
- 1. Setting and marking classwork and internal examinations according to school's assessment policy
- 2. Completing semester and other reports

- C. Project Supervision & Extracurricular activities:
- 1. Supervising projects and coursework as mandated by the school and the IB, including DP Extended Essays, MYP Projects, and subject-specific tasks.
- 2. Supervise CAS/SA, extracurricular activities, and other school functions in and out of normal school hours

D. Administrative Tasks:

- 1. Attending all required meetings, including staff and departmental meetings, as well as compulsory school events
- 2. Performing any other duties as required by the Principal for the benefit of the College

E. Professional Development & Safeguarding:

- 1. Attending and completing workshops and courses as required by the school for ongoing training in the subject and syllabuses
- 2. Safeguarding the welfare of students, and upholding the school's commitment to child protection in all professional interactions

III. COMPETENCIES

- Minimum qualification first degree from a recognized University in Geography
- A Master's degree in Geography is an added advantage.
- Knowledge of the IB DP and MYP syllabi will be a bonus.

- A graduate subject specialist preferably with a teaching certification
- A minimum of 5 years of teaching experience in a reputable institution is preferred although 3 years of experience under certain circumstances will be acceptable.

The ideal candidate should:

- Be open to learning
- Have a deep understanding of the subject and enthusiasm for inquiry-based learning
- Be collaborative
- Have a genuine care for student well-being and academic development; ability to scaffold learning for diverse needs.
- Be willing to review and improve teaching practices based on feedback and outcomes.
- Have a strong alignment with IB and the College's values such as integrity, respect, and academic honesty.
